## NEU Industrial Action : 15 and 16 March 2023

Further to the Microsoft Office Form that was sent out last week, we can confirm the arrangements that Seaford Head School will be making on 15 and 16 March. Although the majority of teaching staff at Seaford Head are NEU members, we have been able to make provision for all the children whose parents/carers have requested it on these days.

Although this provision will be very different to a “typical” day, activities will be safe and meaningful independent study tasks. For the majority of the day, students will be supervised whilst they complete the work that is available through Teams.

Students who are not on site will also be able to work independently on tasks available through Teams. There are tasks available through Sparx, Bedrock and Oak National Academy. As students are preparing for exams there is also the opportunity to undertake revision and exam preparation. It is very important that all students are engaged in meaningful learning for the two days. If you are concerned that your child will not be able to study at home please register them for the on-site provision.

For safeguarding purposes, it is very important that we have an accurate record of who will be attending on **each** day. Please notify our Attendance Officer, Mrs J Owen, if you would like your child to attend. She can be emailed directly on [JoanneOwen@seafordhead.org](mailto:JoanneOwen@seafordhead.org). We will prioritise requests based on children’s needs, as outlined on the original form distributed last week. Please contact Mrs Owen before the end of the school day on Tuesday 14 March 2023 if you would like your child to attend or if you earlier made a request for provision that is no longer required.

On 15 and 16 March we are encouraging more of our Year 11 and 13s to be in school. A separate communication has been sent out to students in these year groups. In addition to intervention sessions on Wednesday, all of Year 11 will be invited in for an additional “walking-talking” mock on Thursday in Maths and English. All Year 11s must attend for these sessions in full school uniform.

Other children who have had a place confirmed should attend from 8.30am and register in the hall at Steyne Road. Breakfast club will be open from 8.15am. At lunchtime the canteen at Steyne Road will be open offering a reduced menu for all students attending to purchase lunch if required. Those students who are not in Year 11 will not be required to wear their uniform.

For those students who are eligible for Free School Meals, but not attending school on 15 and 16 March, a Huggg voucher will be issued via email to the parent/carer listed as priority one on the day with an expiry date of 17 March 2023.
