## The Big Futures Show

As part of our ongoing CEIAG and our commitment to meet the eight Gatsby Benchmarks for career provision, we have been able to secure a number of tickets to enable Year 10 students to attend The Big Futures Show on **Tuesday 25th April 2023**. This will take place at Eastbourne Sports Park and students will be supervised throughout the visit by members of staff from Seaford Head School. Students will need to wear full school uniform, bring their lunch and equipment as we will be back for periods 3, 4 and 5. We will be leaving Seaford at 8.50am so students will need to arrive early and meet in the AS dining room no later than 8.30am. Numbers are limited and we will be allocating places on a first come, first served basis.

This is an opportunity for students to meet with a wide variety of further education and training providers and prospective employers.

- Potential employers will be offering interactive exhibits and guidance aimed at inspiring tomorrow's workforce. They will be looking for talent and explaining what qualifications they are looking for and what training and apprenticeships they can offer in the workplace
- Colleges and Universities will be on hand to show what they have to offer, where it fits with employees requirements and what they are looking for in students
- Other training providers will be on hand to discuss the wide range of other possibilities they offer between full time education and into the workplace with training
- There will be representation from a variety of other organisations that offer young people personal development opportunities. In addition there will be occasional speakers and a variety of related ad hoc attractions
- This will be an ideal opportunity for students to consider their part in the workforce of the future
- On arrival students will be presented with a professional show like any industry show they might visit during their working life. It will be an opportunity to meet educators, trainers and employers in a truly business like environment
- There will be 'show hosts' on hand throughout the show to help steer students round and keep them focused on the job in hand
- After the show the school will have follow-up material to help them summarise what they got from their visit

There is a charge of **£9.50** to cover the cost of entrance and transport.
