Dear Parents/Carers

NEU Industrial Action : 27 April and 2 May 2023

I am writing to confirm the arrangements that Seaford Head School will be making on 27 April and 2 May 2023. We are hoping to make provision for all the children whose parents/carers request it for these days.

Although this provision will be very different to a “typical” day, activities will be safe and meaningful independent study tasks. For the majority of the day, students will be supervised whilst they complete the work that is available through Teams.

Year 11 & 13 students will be expected to be on site as normal and they will be following their usual school timetable. Year 11s will be expected to be in their usual school uniform.

Students in the other year groups who are not on site will also be able to work independently on tasks available through Teams. There are tasks available through Sparx, Bedrock and Oak National Academy.

For safeguarding purposes, it is very important that we have an accurate record of who will be attending on the day. Please complete the Microsoft Office form by noon on Monday 24 April 2023 if you would like on site provision for your child that has been sent out via Edulink. The form can also be found [here](#). We are expecting all students in Years 11 and 13 to attend and the form does not need to be completed for students in these year groups.

On the above dates, provision for Years 7, 8, 9, 10 & 12 will be made on the Steyne Road site or S6H and students accessing this provision do not need to wear uniform, but those attending school must be dressed appropriately. Children who have had a place confirmed should attend from 8.30am and register in the hall at Steyne Road. Breakfast club will be open from 8.15am. The canteen on the Arundel Road site will also be offering a reduced menu. At lunchtime the canteen at Steyne Road will be open offering a reduced menu for all students attending to purchase lunch if required. Lessons for Year 11 and Year 13 will take place in their usual classrooms.

For those students who are eligible for Free School Meals, but not attending school on the above dates, a Hugg voucher will be issued via email to the parent/carer listed as priority one on 2 May 2023 with an expiry date of 3 May 2023.
