

## What to bring... (Kit List)

The weather in Boulogne in June is likely to be very similar to the weather in the South of England; sometimes sunny, sometimes chilly and sometimes raining. The average temperature during the day is approximately 18°C.

Here are some things that you might need;

- A backpack to carry packed lunch etc.
- A small refillable water bottle to carry with you at all times
- A small bottle of antibacterial hand gel
- A surgical facemask\*
- Sun cream
- Sun hat
- Anorak
- Umbrella
- T-shirts
- Trousers
- Jeans
- Leggings
- Shorts
- Jumpers
- Skirts
- Party clothes
- Pyjamas
- Slippers
- Flip-flops
- Underwear
- Comfortable shoes (we do quite a lot of walking!)
- Wash bag (don't forget your toothbrush!)
- Pencil Case with pens, pencils, scissors and glue for Journal and Trip Booklet
- Colouring pencils for the museum workbook
- A travel pillow for the coach
- Any medication that you are on (please hand to First Aider)
- A small gift for your Pen-Pal (optional)

\* Face masks are not compulsory, but it is recommended to bring one in case you feel that you need to use it

Hairdryer / Straighteners, European plug adaptors, Shampoo / Shower gel etc.

You are free to bring the following items, but you are responsible for their safety.

Camera, Mobile (Remember your charger and adaptor. There may be a charge for using your mobile in Europe so please check with your phone company before travel).
