GCSE Geography

The Geography department is planning a Physical Fieldwork trip to Seaford beach this July. This is the second of two compulsory fieldwork trips and is essential because your child will be assessed on their acquired skills in June 2024 when they sit the Paper 3 exam.

Depending on which teaching group your child is in this will take place on:

Tuesday 4th July- 10C1, 10C2 and 10D1 Wednesday 5th July- 10B1 and 10B2

Students will meet in the canteen at 8:50am. They will be out of school during Periods 1-4 (8:50am – 1.30pm). They will need to wear practical clothing for walking to and from the beach and for collecting data, have a waterproof coat in the instance of adverse weather conditions, a clipboard, pen, pencil and bring a snack/drink.

Students will need to bring their equipment for period 5 and their lunch.
