




What is the Seaford Head Colour Dash?

Need to know.

- Don't wear any expensive clothing. We recommend that you wear old, white/light coloured clothing to show the colour powder more vibrantly.
- The coloured powder is safe, non-toxic and non flammable. The
 powder will not stain if used appropriately. Water will cause the
 powder to be turned into paint, which if combined may stain clothes.
 Therefore, anyone seen throwing water will be removed from the run.
- The colour powder is made from corn starch, dyed with food colouring and allergen free.

Route 1: Students will walk or run around the field in a one way system. There will be a first aid point near the start and finish, with first aiders placed along the edge of the route.
