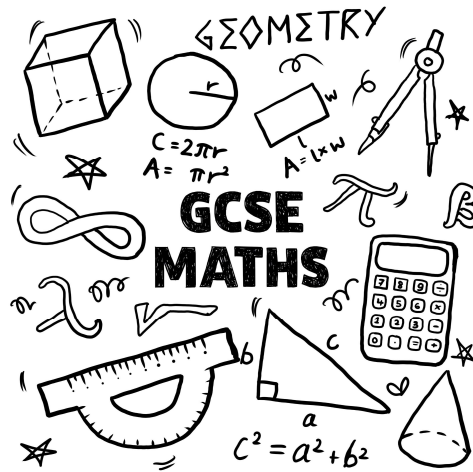

Edexcel Exam Board

Two tiers:

- Foundation Grades 1-5
- Higher Grades 3-9

3 maths exams – each 90 minutes long

- 1 non-calculator paper
- 2 calculator papers

- Paper 3 – Calculator – 10<sup>th</sup> June 2024

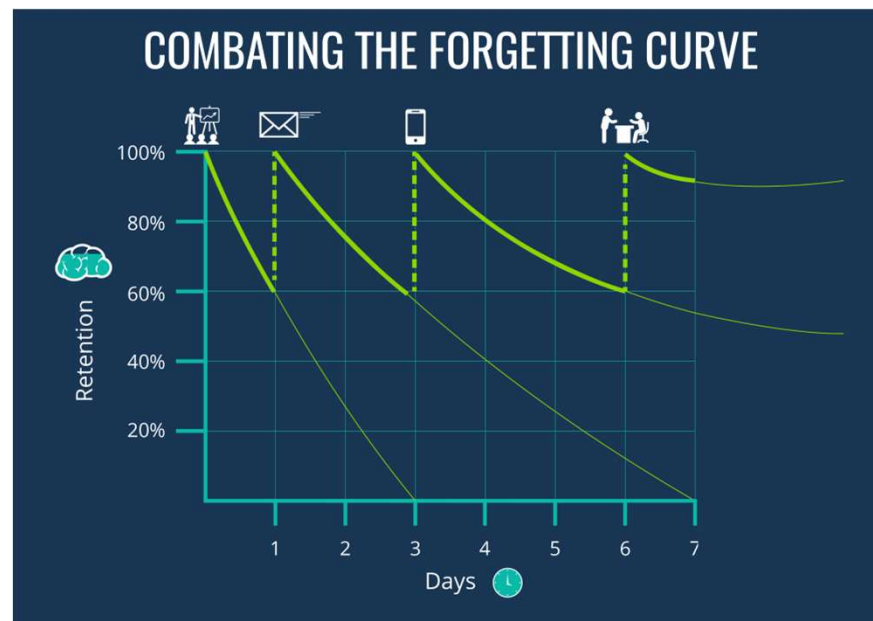

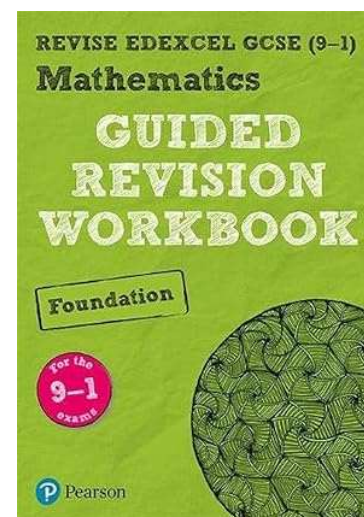

# Good exam technique



- Showing all working out clearly and in a logical manner
- Doing what the questions asks
- Understanding key words such as factorise and evaluate
- Drawing diagrams where possible
- Being careful with rounding and units
- Checking your answer makes sense at the end

- Be as positive as possible about Maths
- Talk through real life Maths problems:
  - Measuring
  - Best buy questions / budgets
  - Gas meters, phone tariffs, electricity bills
  - Bank accounts
  - Currencies and exchange rates
- Having the correct equipment- including a scientific calculator.
- Encourage the explaining of answers
