**WORKSHOP AND THEATRE TRIP: 'FEEL ME' BY THE PAPER BIRDS  
THURSDAY 22 FEBRUARY 2024**

We have been able to secure a limited number of tickets for students to participate in a workshop and attend an evening performance of 'Feel Me' by The Paper Birds. The workshop will be held in the Arundel Site Hall and the performance will be at The Show Room in Chichester. Both events will take place on Thursday 22 February 2024.

This is a great opportunity for students to experience a quality piece of theatre in a professional setting, as well as working with the company beforehand. The cost of this visit will be £35.50 per student, which includes the workshop, theatre ticket, coach travel and insurance.

**Information About 'Feel Me'**

**Show interaction:** During the performance, you will need your phone turned on, but set on silent.

At certain points during the performance, we will ask members of the audience to interact via their phones. We would love everybody to take part in this, but it is optional and will not affect the audience understanding of the show.

If you choose to take part, all answers will be anonymous. Questions will be asked about what you are watching and how you feel. If you do not have a device with you, we have a limited number of tablets available on a 'first-come-first-served' basis, available from the front of house team. The show contains mild strobing in the projections, loud noises and atmosphere haze.
