## Theatre Trip – The Woman in Black

We have been able to secure a limited number of tickets for students to see an afternoon performance of *The Woman in Black* at The Theatre Royal in Brighton on Thursday 29 February 2024.

This is a great opportunity for students to experience a high quality piece of theatre in a professional setting.

Should the trip prove over popular we will run a ballot system, so all students have a fair opportunity to attend. The cost of this visit is £21 per student, which includes the theatre ticket, travel (by train) and insurance.

The travel arrangements for the trip are outlined below:

**Time:** Meet at the Steyne Site Drama Room at 12.30pm and walk to Seaford Station. Train to Brighton (1.24pm)

**Performance:** 2:30pm – 4.30pm

**Return:** Students will return on the train (5.06pm) and return to the Steyne Site at around 5.30pm.

Tickets can be purchased via ParentPay. The deadline is **Thursday 8 February 2024**. Please indicate if you will be collecting your child upon our return or whether you will make alternative arrangements for them.
