We have been offered the fantastic opportunity to take a group of students to St John's College at the University of Oxford for an immersion day on **Friday 26 January 2024**. The students will spend the day learning about life at one of the top universities in the world and talk to current students about their experiences. Places are limited, but I am pleased to say we can offer your child a place.

We will leave Seaford Head via school minibus at 07:00 (meet at 06:45 at Arundel reception) and hope to be back at approximately 18:30 (traffic permitting). Students should be in full school uniform and bring their school bag containing snacks, drinks, a pencil case and notebook.

The programme for the day:

- 10:30 Arrival at St John's College
- 10:45 Oxford Explained presentation: This talk focuses on introducing students to the University of Oxford, the courses and societies it has to offer and the application process. It includes information on financial support available at the University, the practicalities of picking a course and a college and illustrates practical ways in which students can engage with their subjects outside the classroom.
- 11:30 Tour of St John's
- 12:00 Lunch: A free lunch is provided alongside current St John's Students.
