Dear Parents/Carers

Trip to Plumpton Racecourse - Monday 26 February 2024

Please find the following instructions for students attending the Maths trip to Plumpton Racecourse on Monday 26 February 2024.

1. The trip has 30 participants and will involve outdoor activities at the racecourse

Student Clothing

2. School uniform must be worn – extra jumpers/fleeces/hoodies are allowed given the chilly wet weather
Comfortable shoes (e.g. trainers) that enable walking to and from the station
Warm and/or waterproof coats – it is likely to be cold and/or rainy on the day and most of the activities are outside
3. Students must bring a packed lunch, water and any snacks required. If your child is entitled to FSM a packed lunch will be provided for them. There will be no opportunity to buy refreshments during the day.

4. Your child will need to arrive at school (Steyne Road) by **8.10am** to meet in the I room to be registered and briefed before walking to Seaford Station. Students will walk together with teachers to Seaford Station from the Steyne Site. If your child has not arrived and registered by 8.15am we will need to ensure we catch our train and will unfortunately have to leave without them. Therefore, when they arrive they will remain at school for the day.

Return to school by 3.30pm

We will be returning to Seaford Station at 3.18pm. **Please let me know if you would prefer for your child to be dismissed at Seaford (or Bishopstone or Newhaven) station** rather than return to the school. Email me at helengreen@seafordhead.org if you would like to give your permission for this.
