Trip to Plumpton Racecourse Monday 26 February 2024

This is a final reminder for students attending the maths trip to Plumpton Race Course on Monday 26 February 2024.

1. The trip has 30 participants and will involve outdoor activities at the racecourse.

Student Clothing

2. School uniform must be worn – extra jumpers/fleeces/hoodies are allowed given the chilly wet weather.
Comfortable shoes (e.g. trainers) that enable walking to and from the station
Warm and/or waterproof coats – it is likely to be cold and/or rainy on the day and most of the activities are outdoor.
3. Students must bring a packed lunch, water and any snacks required (apart from students who receive free school meals – a packed lunch will be provided by the school).
There will be no opportunity to buy refreshments during the day.

Students will walk together with teachers to Seaford station from the Steyne Site.

Return to school by 3.30pm.
