AQA A-Level Geography Grade Booster Workshop

We have been able to obtain a limited number of tickets to enable students to attend an A-Level Geography Grade Booster Workshop at the Vue Cinema, Westfield Stratford on Tuesday 19 March 2024

The intensive Grade Booster workshop format is designed to:

- Refine and sharpen key exam technique for the two AQA A Level Geography papers
- Build confidence in the essential assessment skills
- Provide a clear focus and structure for students on how to make the most effective use of their remaining revision time for the first AQA A Level Geography exam in May 2024.

The AQA A Level Geography Grade Booster Workshop combines:

- Four hours of intensive large-group tuition by Tutor2u's experienced A Level Geography presenter team
- A workshop booklet containing all the session content, extension activities, guidance on examboard specific exam technique and other essential revision materials designed for students at the end of the A Level Geography course.
