A-Level Geography Fieldwork Trip – Alfriston

It is now a compulsory element of the Geography A-Level examination for students to undertake an NEA worth 20% of their final A-Level grade. In order to prepare them for this we complete a mock NEA fieldtrip to Alfriston as part of a group. This builds student's confidence and allows them to share ideas. Students have been preparing for this over the past several lessons.

The fieldtrip will take us to Alfriston where we will study the human and physical geography of the village and how this impacts on 'sense of place'.

The fieldtrip will take place on Friday 14 June 2024. The day will start at 10:00am. All students should meet in the Steyne Road site car park. Travel will be in the school minibus driven by Mr Still. We will return to school by 2:00pm.
