Dear Parents and Carers,

Paris 2025

As part of the Year 12 and 13 English and French courses for A-level, we are thrilled to be able to run another trip to Paris.

We ran the trip last year with huge success and students felt it complemented their study of the Paris Anthology and the French language, as well as their culture more broadly. It is also aimed to be an enriching experience for the students.

We will be leaving on the morning of Friday 28 March and returning late in the evening of Monday 31 March 2025. We will travel to and from Paris by coach and take the Eurotunnel from Folkestone. Please ensure that the passport of the person travelling is valid for at least three months after the 28 March, as these are the current travel rules in Europe. They must also hold a valid EHIC card.

The trip includes a river cruise along the Seine, a visit to the Louvre, a tour of the Montmartre area and a day at Disneyland. The price also covers two evening meals in a restaurant in Paris. The students will also have some free time to explore the city. Accommodation is in a central Bed and Breakfast.

There **are 40 places available** for the trip and parents/carers must consent on ParentPay. The cost of the trip will be £496.00 and an initial deposit of £150.00 is required by 13 October 2024, with the additional following instalments required on:

30 November £173.00 31 December £173.00

Students will need to bring additional money for lunches, one evening dinner and spending money. This trip is not an obligation, but rather an opportunity for students.

If the trip is oversubscribed, a random ballot will take place and you will be informed if your child has been allocated a place. If any students are unsuccessful your deposit will be refunded. Further details and more information will follow.
