Geography Field Trip to Alfriston – Friday 22 May 2026

This compulsory field trip forms an important part of the A-level Geography course. It will provide students with the opportunity to develop their understanding of fieldwork, sampling, and evaluative techniques in preparation for their Non-Examined Assessment (NEA). In addition, students will gain a deeper understanding of Alfriston as a local place, including how it has changed over time both economically and demographically. This will support their learning for Paper 2 of the A-level Geography examination.
