Dear Parents/Carers,

I am writing to inform you of the Year 12 Uniformed Protective Services Leadership Challenge Day which is being led by the British Army, taking place on Monday 9 March 2026.

As part of the UPS course here at Seaford Head, your child will need to undertake various Uniformed Service Challenge Days which focus on Teamwork, Leadership and Communication which are in place to increase subject knowledge for Unit 5: Teamwork, leadership and communication.

The trip will be taken by Mr Ross Sutton (Course Leader) with pupils required to perform various challenges which will be led by the British Army.

The trip has been fully funded by the school and pupils will only be required to bring a packed lunch with them on the day. Students will be given a ration pack provided by the British Army as well. I would also recommend a water bottle as the challenges will be of practical nature. Pupils will need to have suitable sports wear clothing for the trip which includes suitable footwear.
