Year 8 and Year 9 Languages Careers Fair 18 March, 10.00-12.00

We would like to invite your child to attend our Languages Careers Fair.

Seaford Head School has recently become a European Parliament Ambassador School. The European Ambassador Schools programme enables students to learn more about European parliamentary democracy and challenges them to organise practical activities related to the EU. As part of this initiative our language students, with support from their teachers and our Careers Team, have organised the fair to inform students about a wide range of different careers that involve languages.

The fair will be held on Wednesday 18 March 2026 and will run from 10am to 12pm at the Seaford Head Sixth Form Centre. It is a great opportunity to find out more about where languages can take you by meeting professionals who are using languages as well as students that are studying them at A Level and in university.

During this event, students will be able to:

- Attend taster sessions for A Level Mandarin, French, Spanish & German
- Speak to a range of professionals from the community who value languages
- Meet a legal adviser and an Interpreter from the European Union
- Speak to a Sussex University Associate Professor and student language ambassadors who will present degrees they offer that can be combined with language study
- Experience France and Spain with a VR headset
- Listen to speeches by current A Level students as well as our esteemed exhibitors

For Year 8: Students will leave their P1 at 9.30am and meet a member of staff by reception. They will be escorted to the Sixth Form Centre and brought back at the end of P3 to go back to their lessons.

For Year 9: Students will leave their P1 at 9.25am and walk down to be registered in the Sixth Form Centre at 9.45am. At the end of the event, students will walk back to the Arundel Road site to be registered at the beginning of P4.

Please complete consent for your child to attend on ParentPay. We have a maximum number of attendees for this event, and in the case of the fair being oversubscribed, we will offer places after a ballot has taken place. Consent for the fair must be provided by Wednesday 11 March.
