



Dear future Seaford Head Families,

We are delighted to share that we will once again be working with Steps Up Ltd, the local organisation that has successfully delivered our summer activity programmes since 2021. Our Summer School Programme will run from **Monday 27th July to Wednesday 29th July 2026**. As your child will be joining Seaford Head School in September, and making their transition into secondary school, we would like to provide them with the opportunity to get to know the school, some of the staff and other students who will be moving up to Seaford Head School this September. We will also invite the current year 7 students so new students get to know older students to help ease any anxieties some students may have.

The following part of the letter comes directly from 'Steps Up' – the organisation that are solely responsible for running the programme.

We aim to focus on a wide range of outcomes, such as confidence and wellbeing, through delivering activities such as sport, fitness, music, drama and art. Steps Up Summer Activities are specifically designed to ease the transition process for pupils from primary to secondary education.

This is not a week of extra English and Maths!

Teachers, Learning Mentors and Coaches will work with students to make the move from primary school a happy and enjoyable time. We deliver organised activities where children can get to know each other and also discuss children's' expectations of secondary schools and what will be expected of them when they move in to Year 7. This is a useful way of familiarising children with Seaford Head School and dispelling myths about secondary school.

Steps Up will offer an exciting series of interactive workshops, energetic activities and fun-filled challenges specifically designed to inspire and enable each and every student to uncover their unique abilities, develop greater confidence and master strategies for success in the classroom and beyond. Some of the activities included are;

The Summer Activities Programme will run from 8.30 - 3.00pm on **Monday 27th July to Wednesday 29th July inclusively.**

The Summer School Programme will cost **£100 for the full three days** or **£40 per day.**

If your child is in receipt of **Free School Meals** then the cost of your child's place will be **subsidised.**

Sign up to **one** day and **pay only £10 instead of £40**

Sign up to **two** days and **pay only £15 instead of £80**

Sign up to **three** days and **pay only £20 instead of £100**

If you care for a Looked after Child, please request funding through your child's primary school via the PEP.

If your child would like to attend the Summer Activities Programme please visit www.steps-up.co.uk and fill out the online registration form or you can fill in the registration form attached and return it to the school office. You will need to pay a **non-refundable deposit of £40 (£10 if in receipt of Free School Meals)** to secure your child's place at time of booking. Once your child's place is booked we will be in touch with further information.

Payments can be made via BACS to the account below. If you would like to pay in instalments please pay the £40 deposit and we will contact you to discuss options.
