Dear Parent/Carer,

I am writing to you to inform you of the Year 12 Uniformed Protective Services Careers trip to Seaford Fire Station which will be taking place on Friday 8 May 2026.

As part of the UPS course here at Seaford Head, your child has various career opportunities to visit local or national public services, with this trip being an opportunity to gain understanding of different careers in the fire and rescue services.

There will be no cost to this trip as this event is being delivered by Seaford Fire & Rescue team to give local community students the opportunity to visit the station.

Students will need to meet at the Arundel Road site minibus at 9.40am where they will be taken to the Fire Station for a 10.00am start. The day will consist of a guided tour of the facility, with opportunity to view equipment and see the day-to-day running of the station. Students will have a careers seminar from 11.00am, with lunch at 12.00pm. Students will need to bring a packed lunch with them on the day. The approximate finish time is 1.00pm.

Once the visit has finished, students who have a Period 5 or 6 lesson will be taken back to college in the minibus. Those who do not have a further lesson that day, will be allowed to leave from the event.
