# The bag!

## One small cabin bag



- Maximum size 45 x 36 x 20cm (including any handles and wheels)
- Includes items like a small trolley case, handbag, rucksack and laptop bag, but please check dimensions
- Needs to fit under the seat in front of you
- Maximum weight 15kg. You need to be able to lift and carry the bag yourself

*If your bag is bigger than this then you will be charged up to £48 (per flight) at the gate and the bag will be put in the hold. The school will not reimburse this cost.*

- Phone charger
- Light towel (or can rent from the hostel for €5)
- Socket adaptor
- Toiletries remember sun cream
- Passport and GHIC card
- Snacks for journey on departure day (/money for food at airport)
- Spending Money: Euros (bank cards - exchange rate – suggested €50 per day)
- Medicines as necessary (with details for administering) – staff will take these
- Mobile – **be aware, data and calls may not be the same as the UK.**
- Nothing sharp – aerosols etc.

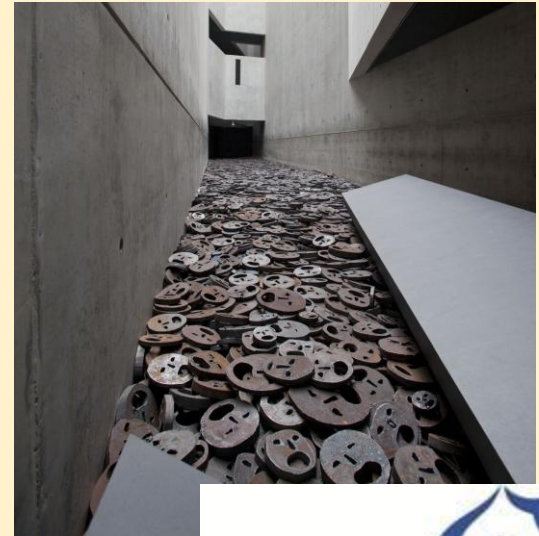
