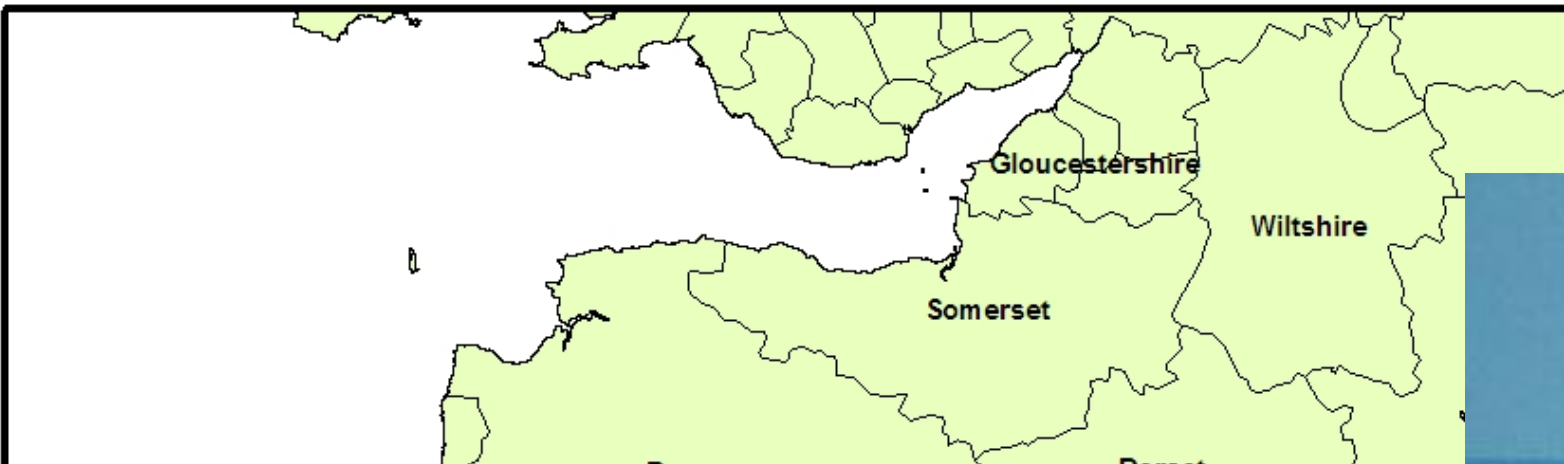

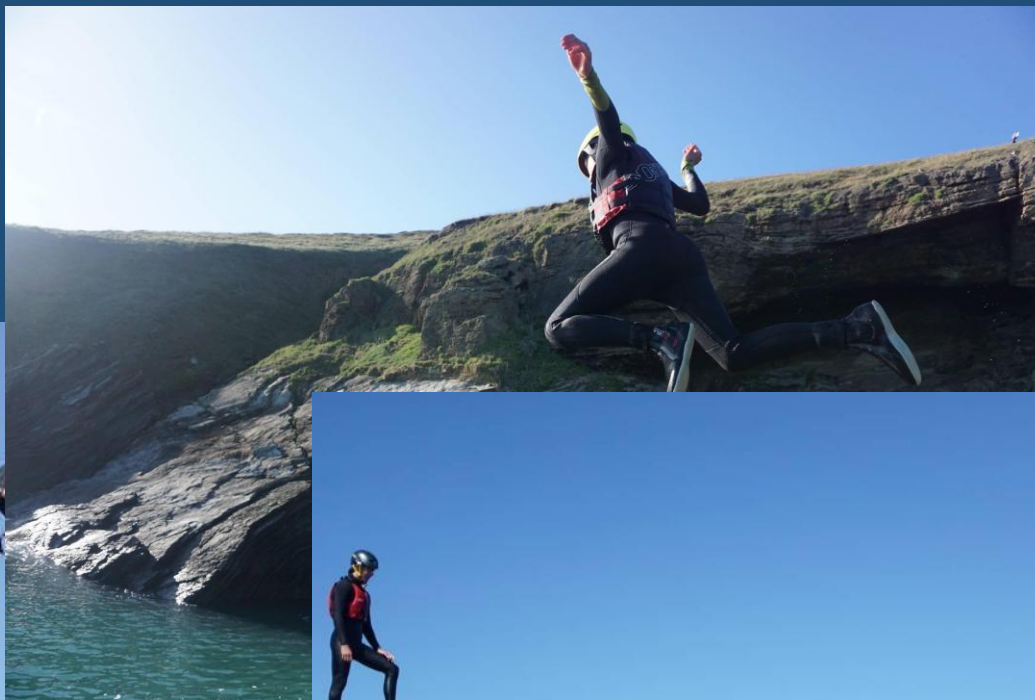

Mobile phones



- As a school we have a no phone policy. On a trip students will be allowed to take their phones to use while travelling, these will be handed in on arrival to the hotel, labelled and kept in the hotel safe.
- Students will be allowed their phones for a designated period of time each evening to call home, they will then be collected in.
- No phones are allowed in the rooms overnight
- If you need to contact your child, call school. We will have a trip phone that the school will call us on.

Rooms



- Students will be put into rooms with at least 1 friend
- Please submit 2 friend requests to Ms Harris (boys/girls will not share)
- Apartments vary in size, each with 2-4 bedrooms of 1-4 beds.
- Students are not allowed in each other's rooms. There is a communal space with table tennis, a pool table and sofas to 'hang out' in.
- We will also be carrying out regular unannounced room checks throughout the stay. These will be presented positively as part of keeping rooms tidy and respectful, with rewards for the best-kept rooms, this will also allow staff to monitor the accommodation generally and address any concerns early.

Behaviour

- We will be speaking to all students at the start of the trip about the responsibility they have as representatives of the school.
- We are very fortunate to have access to this opportunity, and we will make clear that any behaviour which jeopardises the reputation of the group or future visits will be taken seriously.
- We have been told that that vape detection measures have been put in place since last year, and any vaping will be taken seriously. Bringing vapes on the visit — may result in parents being asked to collect their child from Devon.
