Dear Parents/Carers

Ski Trip 2027

We are busy planning next year's annual and ever popular Ski Trip to St. Johann, Austria leaving school in the afternoon of **Wednesday 24 March 2027 and returning on Wednesday 31 March 2027.**

The trip is suited to all abilities with 800km of slopes and 120 ski runs providing ample opportunity for all skiers to be challenged.

The charge will be **£1,300**. This price includes:

- Travel will be by luxury coach with TV, DVD player and toilet.
- Five nights half board hotel accommodation
- Five hours of professional ski instruction each day
- One dry ski session in the UK prior to the trip
- Ski Lift Pass for 5 days
- Ski equipment hire (helmet, skis, ski boots and poles)
- A personalised school Ski Trip hoodie
- Evening activities of bowling, sledging and swimming
- Travel Insurance

To support the planning for the trip, can I please ask parents/carers to complete an expression of interest via ParentPay. The deadline for expressions of interest to be received is **9am on Monday 22 June**.

Upon confirmation of a place being allocated to your child, **a non-refundable deposit of £350 is due no later than Wednesday 1 July**. If your deposit payment is not received by this date, the place will be automatically removed and offered to another student.

The remaining balance of £950 will payable over 4 monthly payments as outlined below-

- 1 September £240
- 1 October £240
- 1 November £240
- 1 December £230

Please note that once a student's place on a trip or activity is confirmed you are entering a commitment to pay deposits and all instalments by the stipulated due dates.

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If a student withdraws from a trip, refunds will be considered once the trip has taken place.

Places are limited to 40 students and only students in Year 10 (2026-2027) will be considered. If more than 40 students apply, places will be allocated via a ballot. However, Seaford Head School reserves the right to refuse students who do not meet the following criteria:

- Outstanding attendance record (above 95%)
- Outstanding behaviour record
- Outstanding academic progress (in all subjects)

Your child will also require a valid passport or visa to cross all borders to Austria and a Global Health Insurance Card (GHIC). All parents/carers are requested to keep up to date on the travel restriction guidance to Austria prior to travel to ensure your child can meet the travel requirements.

Please be aware that Seaford Head School will be offering a wide variety of trips and visits over the course of the coming year including other residential visits, plus those in Activities Week. We recognise the financial implications that visits place on parents/carers. We hope you can use this information to plan accordingly.
